

OUTREACH EYECARE PROGRAM

EYE CAMP AT KHORBASAI, Alwar 22TH JANUARY, 2016

The lack of access to specialized medical supervision and treatment has led to a prevalence of blindness amongst the elderly poor people. SAPNA has embarked on an ambitious Outreach Health Program (OHP), wherein it aspires to provide health cover to the poor and needy in Alwar district, Rajasthan.

SAPNA collaborates with the Venu Eye Institute and Research Center, Sheikh Sarai, New Delhi, a leading eye hospital in Delhi, to hold a mobile eye screening camp in rural areas of Alwar district. On January 22th, 2015 a similar mobile eye screening camp was organized at *Khor Basai*, *District Alwar*. The Eye Camp was sponsored by Narendra Modi.

Medicines were provided free of cost, out of an <u>OPD of 210 held, 34 patients</u> screened for cataract were sent to Venu Eye Hospital & Research Center, New Delhi for Cataract surgery. During the whole process, they were facilitated with free food and accommodation at the hospital. The to & fro journey of the patients from Khorbasai to Delhi was arranged through SAPNA by kind courtesy of <u>Manoj Chachan</u>. <u>95 patients</u> were provided specialized glasses free of cost.

Dr. Neha Mishra, Dr. Tinsa, Opticians Mr. Vijay, Optometric team Mr. Vikash and the camp coordinator Mr. Subash Yadav from Venu Eye Institute & Research Centre, New Delhi supported the entire process of camp, and helped SAPNA in making this camp as a success.
