Profile of the Organisation:

NGO 'SAPNA' was registered in Delhi under the Societies Registration Act on 21st October, 2004. It was founded by a group of professionals who shared a dream to work on a people-centric model of development in areas of health, education, gender, community development and social welfare.

Inspired by Gandhian ideals of 'Sewa' i.e. selfless service, SAPNA's mission is to work/act as an 'agent of change' to support and empower the poor and the marginalized.

Delhi Chapter

For its health support project, poor and indigent patients coming to Delhi from far-flung areas of the country are provided all forms of support and care. The organisation's outreach extends to patients accessing medical services at the Safdarjung Hospital and the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, and staying in the hospital Dharamshalas. It also takes care of sick and unknown trauma patients at the Jai Prakash Narayan Apex Trauma Centre (JPNATC) of AIIMS. It supports kidney patients by providing medicines and dialysis on a sustained basis. Another important activity is providing monetary support and facilitating surgery of poor patients in Safdarjung Hospital. Rehab. of destitutes is yet another important activity undertaken by SAPNA. Besides providing ortho-aids, blood donation is undertaken to help needy patients.

Noida Chapter

ANANDAM NOIDA provides short term shelter and care to needy patients accessing medical treatment at Apex hospitals in Delhi.

Alwar Chapter

Old, sick and destitute patients are sheltered at Anandam located at Vijay Mandir & Dadikar. The Mahatma Gandhi Netralaya partners with Venu Eye Institute and Research Centre, Delhi to provide eye care services (cataract surgeries) to the poor in Alwar district.

A Computer Literacy Centre promotes e-learning amongst the rural youth. A BPO provides livelihood to the budding youth of Alwar. A Jan Seva Kendra helps villager's access information and resources through the e-mitra service.

Promoting the 'Swachh Gram Campaign', a Community Water Center provides potable drinking water to the nearby villages at minimal cost. Individual toilets are being constructed to promote hygiene and sanitation. These are steps in the direction of making 'Kaduki' into a model village.

The Mahila Suraksha Evam Salah Kendra is a redressal cum counselling centre for women run in partnership with

the Department of Women & Child and Rajasthan Police.

The 'Support the Girl Child' (Pankhuri) program enables disadvantaged girl children (strength of 24) to access quality education in two neighboring English medium schools and promote all round development. In 2015, a school by the name of 'Sapna Shikshalaya' (present strength of 147) was opened in Vijay Mandir to provide 'quality, flexible and relevant learning' to underprivileged girl children of the area. Under 'Project Turnaround' the organization has adopted a government run residential school for adolescent Muslim girls in village Chandoli. A Community Library supports these endeavors.
