INTRODUCTION

SAPNA (DELHI CHAPTER) works in the field of public healthcare with major public hospitals like AIIMS, Safdarjung & AIIMS Trauma Centre and is touching the lives of more than 250 patients daily.

The main areas of our focus are: -

- Taking care of unattended & poor patients
- Providing support for treatment, medicines, ortho aids & nutrition to the poor and needy
- Providing financial & medical support to poor patients for their surgeries
- Providing shelter, food, medicines and nursing care to unidentified and unattended patients for their rehabilitation
- In the last 3 months of this year 2023, we have had 3 guests visits and were able to showcase our work to churn out donation for expanding our scope from our generous donors like PTI, Magnon etc.



ACTIVITES AT JPN TRAUMA CENTRE OF AIIMS



Sapna attended a total of 118 patients at JPNATC in last 3 months (Jan - Mar 2023)

- 16 patients were rehabbed by Sapna.
- 51 patients were handed over to their family, friends and relatives.
- 32 patients were sent to their homes by our social workers.
- 19 patients were helped for their OPD and tests by our social workers.
- 50 kidney patients were benefitted with kidney medicines.
- 57 dialysis patients were supported with 135 dialysis.
- 3 wheel chairs, 9 suction machines and 4 walkers were given to the poor, unknown and unattended patients.
- Total of 63084 Rs. spent on supporting poor patients with fare to home, providing ortho aids, sponsoring belts, colostomy bags, gloves, rent for Vishram Sadan & many more items.
- Successfully conducted SMPF visit on 25 March

ACTIVITIES AT SAFDARJUNG HOSPITAL & DHARAMSHALA



SAPNA attended to 328 poor patients including 41 cancer & 10 burn patients at Safdarjung Hospital and Dharamshala during this quarter.

- 9 patients were rehabbed by Sapna.
- 268 patients were assisted for their OPD's and tests.
- 591 dozen bananas & 1747 liters of milk were given to patients.
- 7974 food Coupons were given to unknown, unattended patients and their attendants.
- 20500 Rs. were spent in support for patients residing out of station.
- 6 wheelchairs, 1 suction machine and 2 walkers were provided to the poor patients.



Press Trust of India Visit

- 71 blood tests & X-Rays were provided to patients who couldn't afford.
- 63 special lunches & dinners were hosted by various donors at the Safdarjung Dharamshala for utterly poor and needy families.



- NGO Sapna supported cremation of 3 patients.
- Installed Biometric within Delhi Office for better attendance time capturing
- Received new Ambulance from Press Trust of India Ltd. in March 2023





Celebrated Holi at Trauma center, we named it as <u>Sewa Mahotsay</u>. NGO Sapna collaborated with colleges and



NCC and were able to gather 60 volunteers who were serving patients on the festival of Holi. Holi is a very physical festival and due to this there are over 200 plus accidental cases seen in just one day at Trauma center. To make it a seamless day, NGO Sapna provides 60 plus volunteers and train them for registering patients, bathing of patients, taking them for CT scan or X Ray etc.





Anandam Rehab Centre

NOIDA Chapter (Jan - Feb 2023)

SAPNA (NOIDA CHAPTER) works in the field of rehabilitation of poor and destitute patients from Safdarjung & Trauma Center AlIMS Hospital, touching the lives of 10-15 patients on daily basis. It's a short stay home for patients.



- 29 patients were assisted for their OPD's and tests.
- 44 patients were being taken care in last 3 months at Anandam Noida
- ❖ 8 patients on full recovery were sent to home
- Had received 300 kg of ration & 25000 Rs. toiletries from donors

This is a story of a 22 year old boy named Bhoru from Noida Sec 53. Who was brought to Trauma Center AIIMS hospital for his treatment by police. He is a only son to his mother and was lost in Noida.

One day Bhoru was with his mother in the market of Noida Sector 53 and just few moments later he lost his mother in the market. Bhoru has some neuro issues as well, so he was unable to recall his mother's name or phone number. In midst of all this, he met with an accident and was brought to Trauma center AIIMS by Noida police. Here he got the

treatment and was handed over to NGO Sapna for further take care. In due course of time, NGO Sapna took

care of him and one day he again started to speak Noida sector 53. One of the care giver of NGO Sapna (Rafiq) took initiative to visit Noida Sector 53 to look for some clue. It was morning time and care giver asked one of the MCD worker, is there any home with lost boy. He got to know some location of nearby home and slowly and gradually locals recognized the boy and told the home he used to live in. Care giver reached the home and it was most amazing day for that family and his father's brother came to pick him up from Anandam and was very happy to receive; as Bhoru was the only hope for his mother after his father's death. Miracles do happen, all we need to have faith.
