

<u>Inauguration of Sapno ka Ghar (O2) by Shri Pratik</u> <u>Juikar, SDM, Alwar</u>



At NGO Sapna, our mission has always been to uplift the poorest of the poor and provide them with dignity, security, and a better future. With this vision, we initiated the Sapno Ka Ghar project to build homes for families in dire need. After the successful completion of our first Sapno Ka Ghar, we embarked on our second endeavor—to provide a home to 45-yearold Kalu from Village Dadhikar Dhani, Alwar, Rajasthan.

Kalu, a physically handicapped man, had been struggling for years without a proper home. He, his wife, and their young daughter lived in a single-room dwelling that barely provided shelter. Due to his disability, Kalu was unable to work, making it difficult for the family to sustain themselves. His wife, a determined and hardworking woman, work as a labor to fulfil the daily needs of her family.

Recognizing **Kalu's** plight, NGO Sapna decided to build a permanent home for him and his family. The construction of Sapno Ka Ghar-O2 was began in May 2024. The house was designed with a total floor area of 400 square feet, comprising a big room, a kitchen, and a open baranda.

On **4th July 2024**, Sapno Ka Ghar-O2 was inaugurated by **Shri Pratik Juikar, SDM, Alwar.** The total project cost was **₹2.50 lakhs**, thanks to the generous financial support of Shri RRP Singh Sir and his daughters for their generous support.

With immense joy and gratitude, Kalu and his family have now moved into their new home. Sapno Ka Ghar-02 have brought a renewed sense of hope into their lives.

NGO Sapna has also provided two goats to his family under our Goat Rearing Livelihood Program enabling them to earn a stable income for the future.

At NGO Sapna, we remain committed to building more Sapno Ka Ghars, one home at a time, ensuring that every family in need gets a chance to live with dignity. Together, we can turn dreams into reality.

Inauguration of Check Dam (04) by Shri Deepak Pahwa, MD, Bry-Air (Asia) Pvt. Ltd



Inauguration Date: 28th August 2024

As part of our ongoing water conservation efforts in the neighboring villages of Vijay Mandir, Alwar, we have successfully completed the construction of the fourth check dam in village Bala Dehra. This region has been facing acute water scarcity due to a significantly low groundwater level. To address this issue, we have been constructing small check dams to collect rainwater, replenish groundwater, and enhance water availability for the local communities. The fourth check dam was built with the generous financial support of Bry Air (Asia) Pvt. Ltd. under their CSR initiative. Construction began on **May 31, 2024,** and the dam was officially inaugurated on **August 28, 2024,** by **Shri Deepak Pahwa,** Managing Director of **Bry Air (Asia) Pvt. Ltd.** This initiative marks another step toward sustainable water management, ensuring a better future for the region. The details of the dam are given below:
