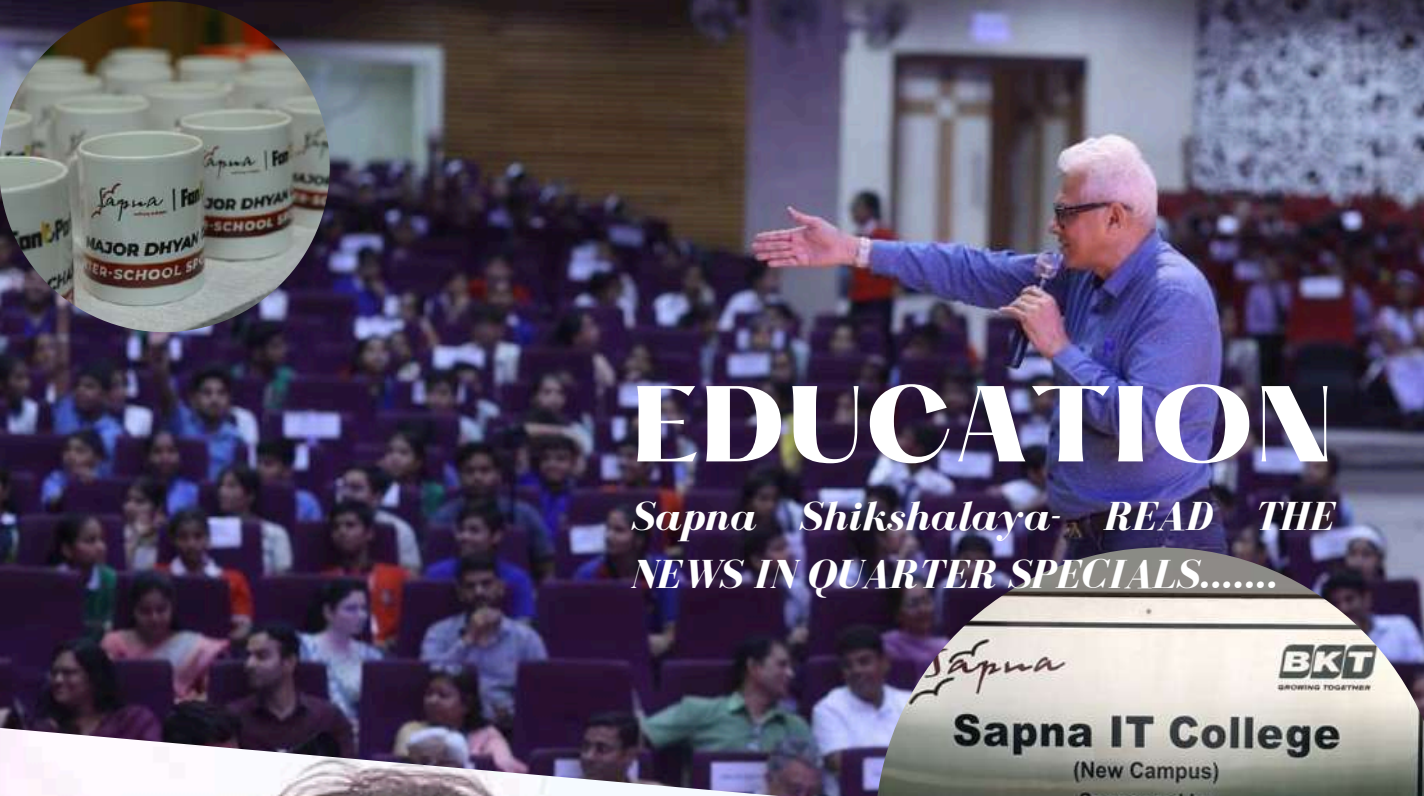

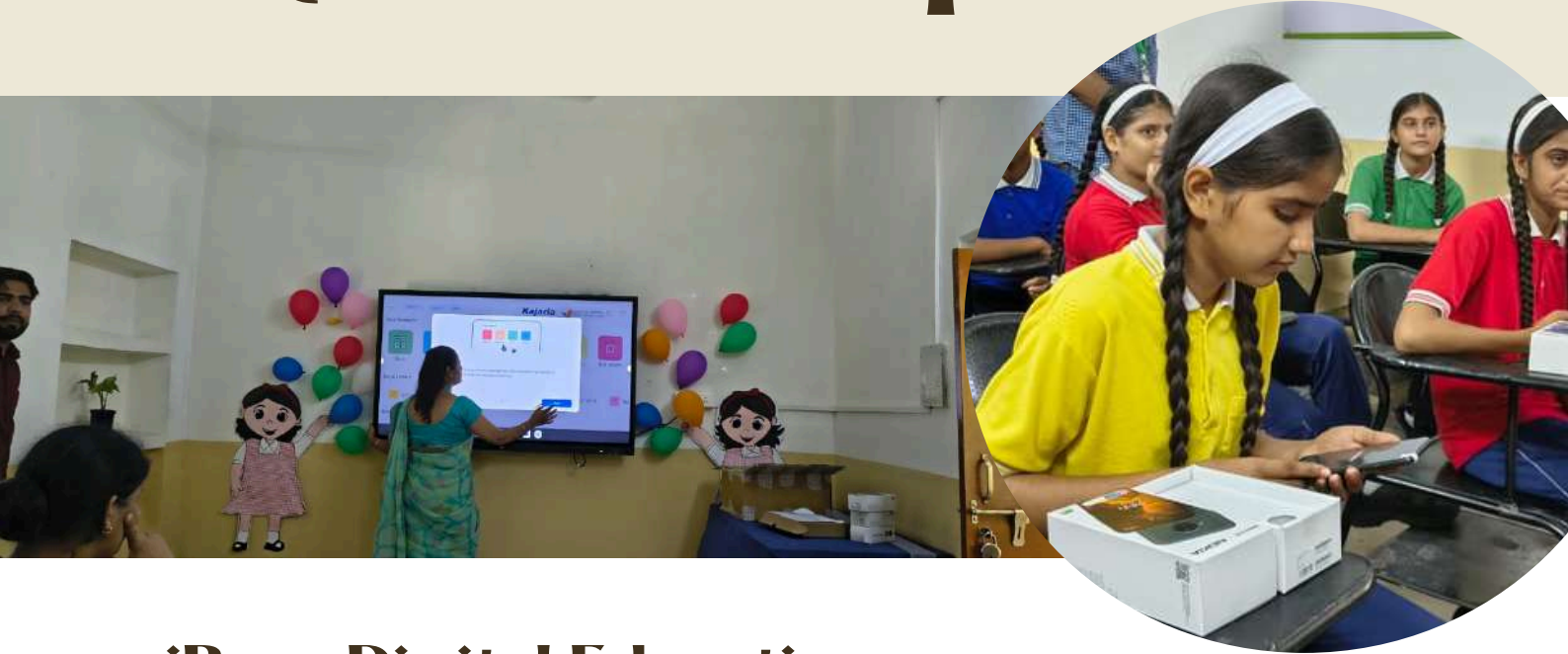

## iPrep Digital Education Program

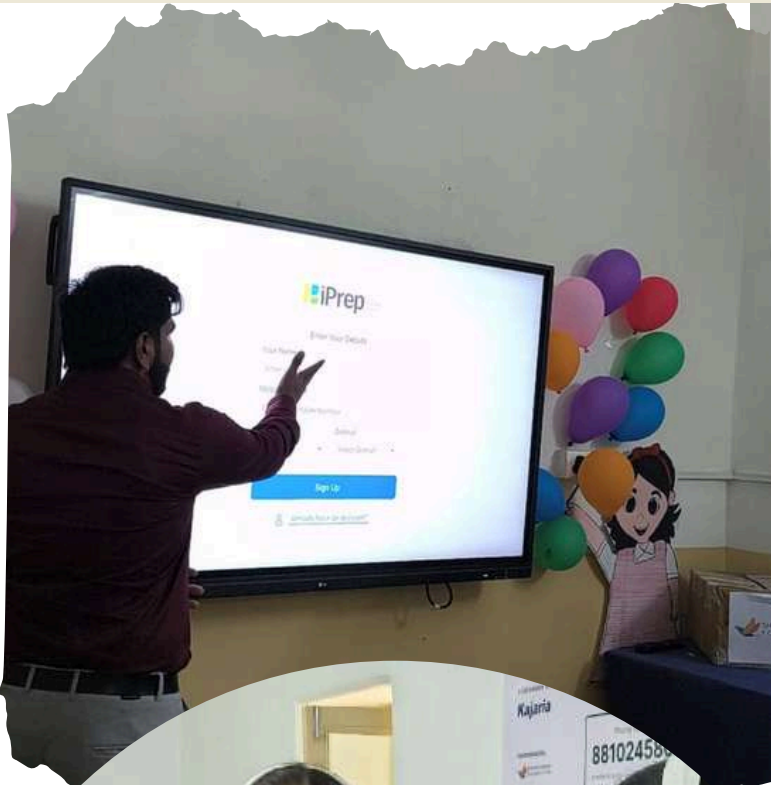

## Patients sent home during in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter



Muskaan aged 40 years, married for 17 years as Mamta Devi was found unaccompanied & mentally deteriorated position near Vijaymandir. Upon her admission to the center on 11<sup>th</sup> September 2025, she began receiving medical treatment.

After she improved her medical condition, she told that her husband lives separately along with 2 of their 3 children from last 4 years. Her 3<sup>rd</sup> child lives with their grandmother. While she lived along with her mother-in-law, brother-in-law and his wife. Sapna social workers confirmed her address, upon agreement from both sides with the intervention of MSSK counselors Mamta returned to her home on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2025.



Meera Devi, age 36 years was transferred to Anandam Vijaymandir on 13.06.2025 from JPNA Trauma Center, New Delhi post head injury.

After her husband died, Meera devi experienced misbehavior leading her to take police action.

During her time at the center, she was accompanied by Sapna social workers – Malti & Anil Saxena to patiyala House court for the court hearing on the matter on 11.07.2025. In the presence of IO Rajendra Kumar Tana Kishangarh, she was handed over to her family on the same day.

Relentless search ended with a phone call on 02.08.2025 from Naamtola Thana where the police informed them about his admission at Anandam center of NGO Sapna since 24.04. 2025 in Alwar, Rajasthan. His brother – Manoj Kumar, thanked the NGO for caretaking his brother. They departed for their home on 10.08. 2025.



Shiv Tiwari, aged 60 years old a security guard worker at a factory in Bhiwadi left his home on 13.08.2025, shortly after he was removed from work.

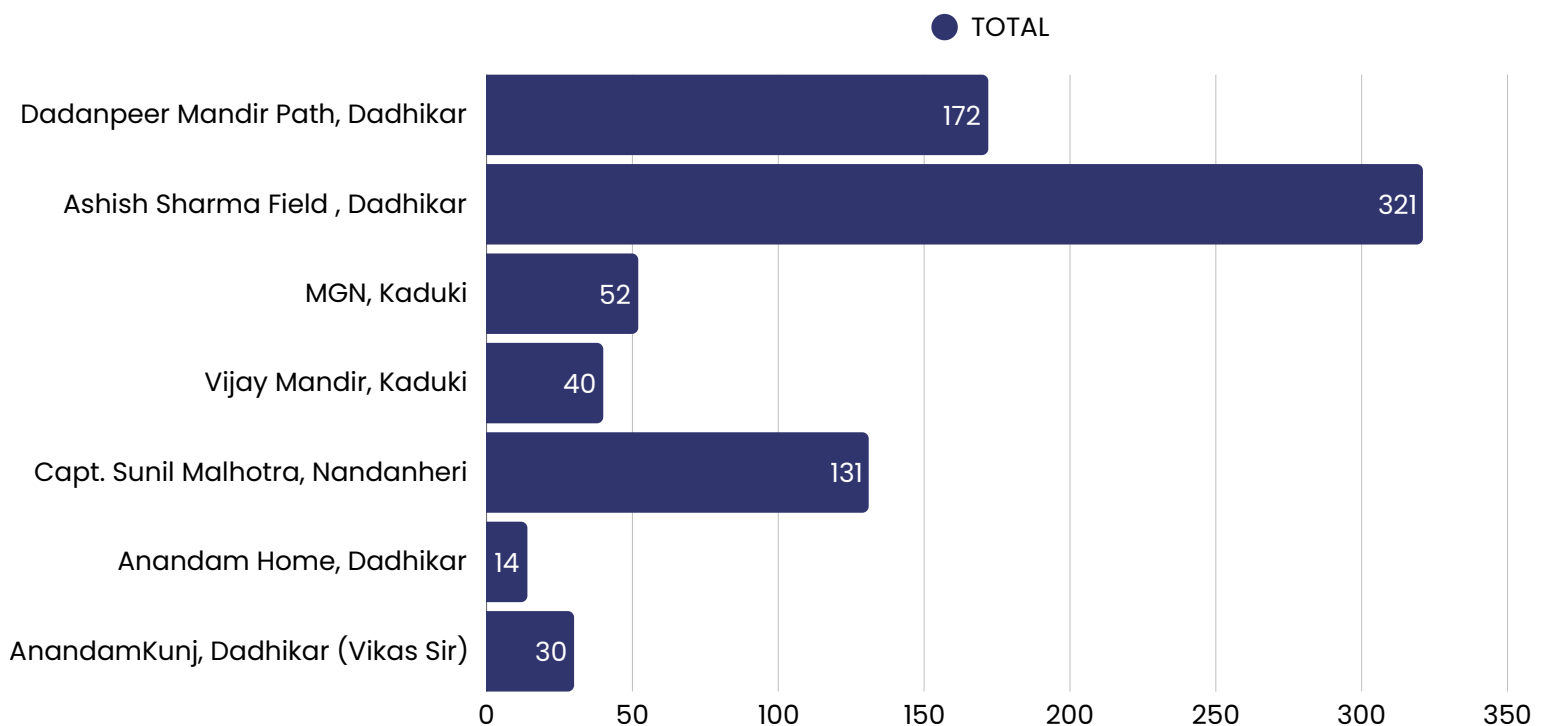


## Tree Plantation Project

- 72 saplings were planted by students of Sapna Shikshalaya at their homes



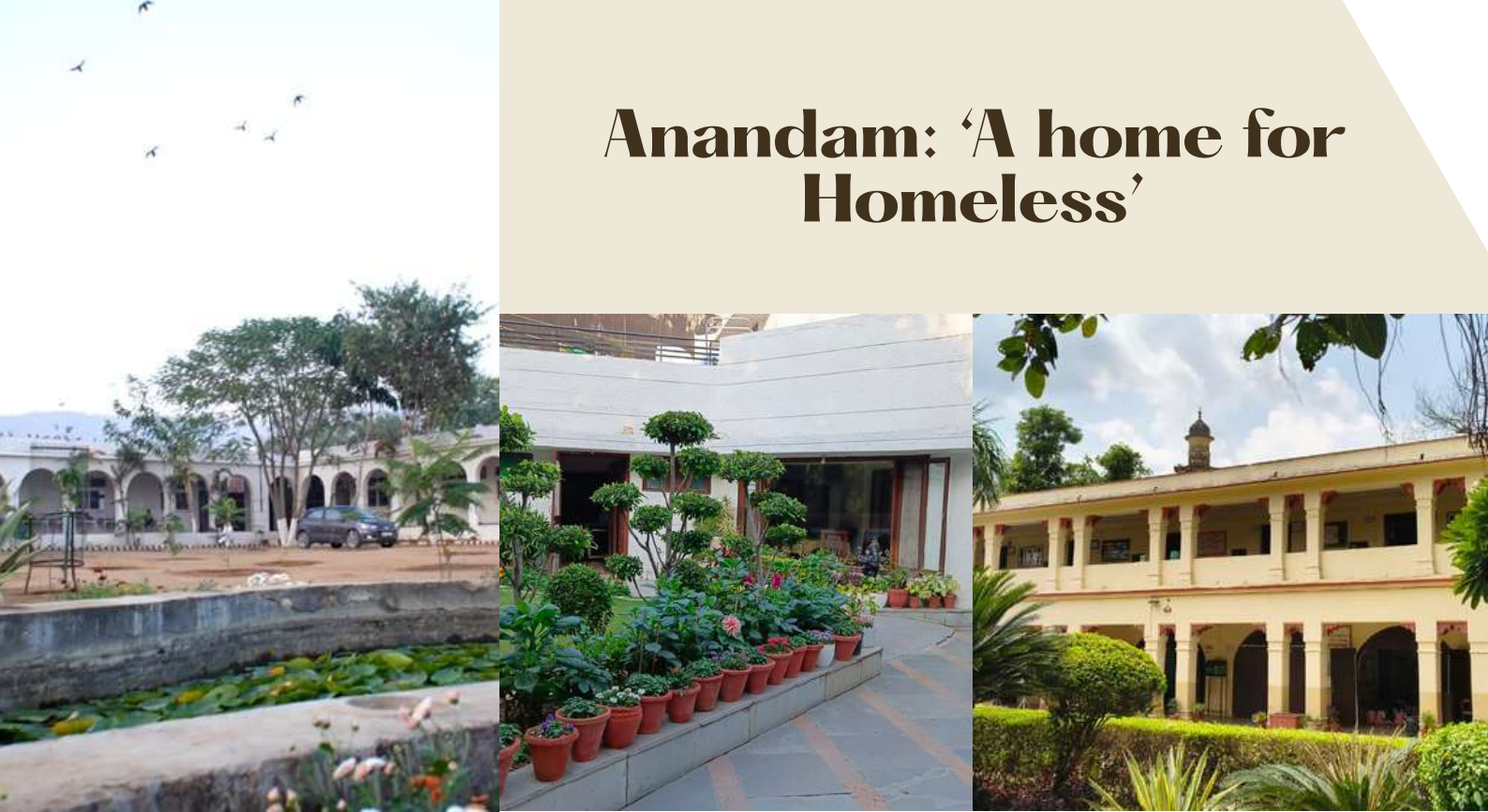

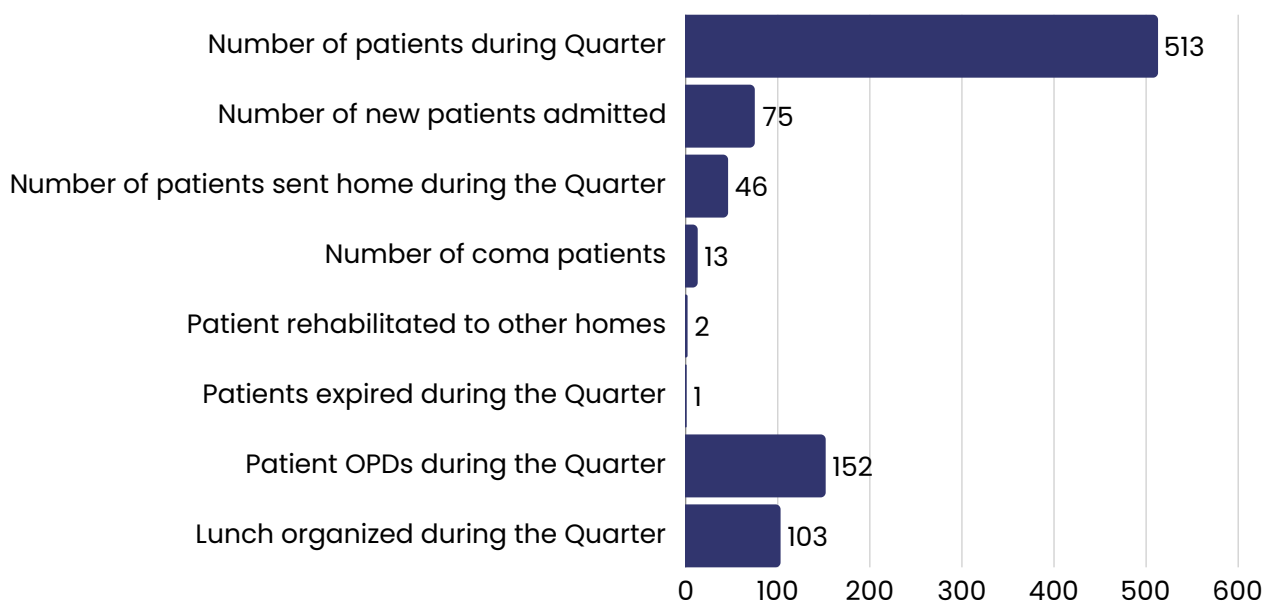
# Anandam: 'A home for Homeless'

# Sapna Shikshalaya

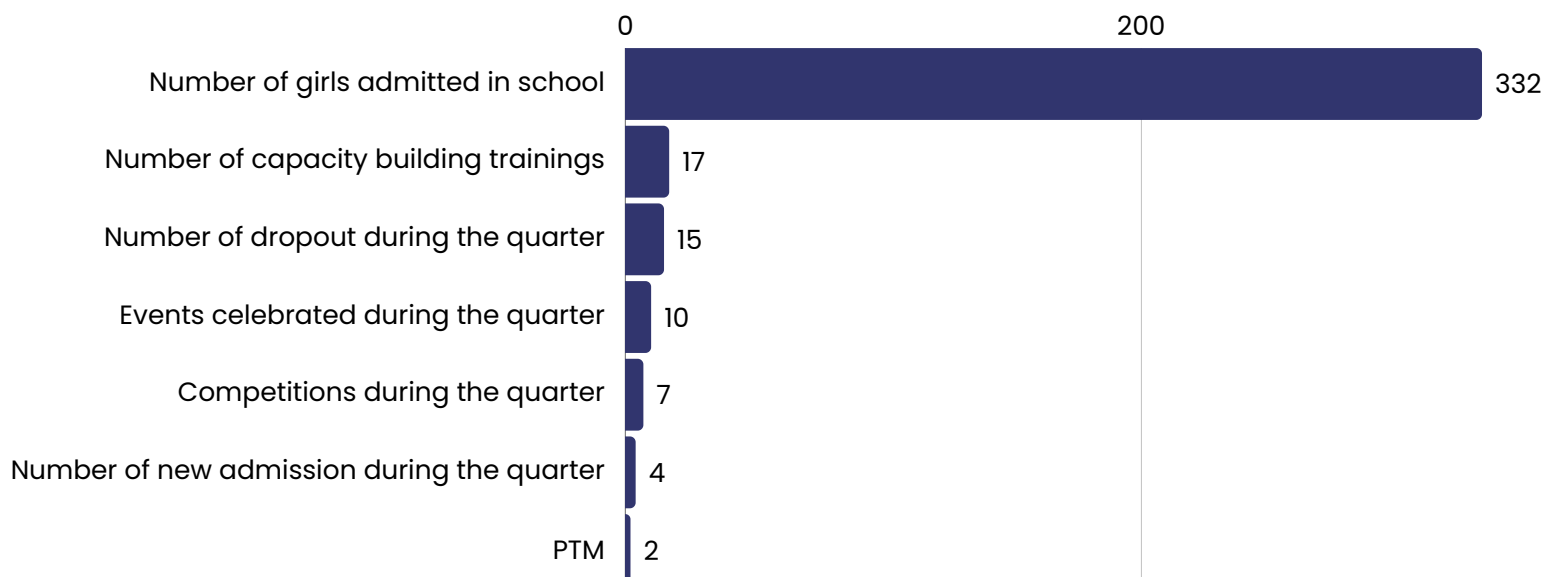

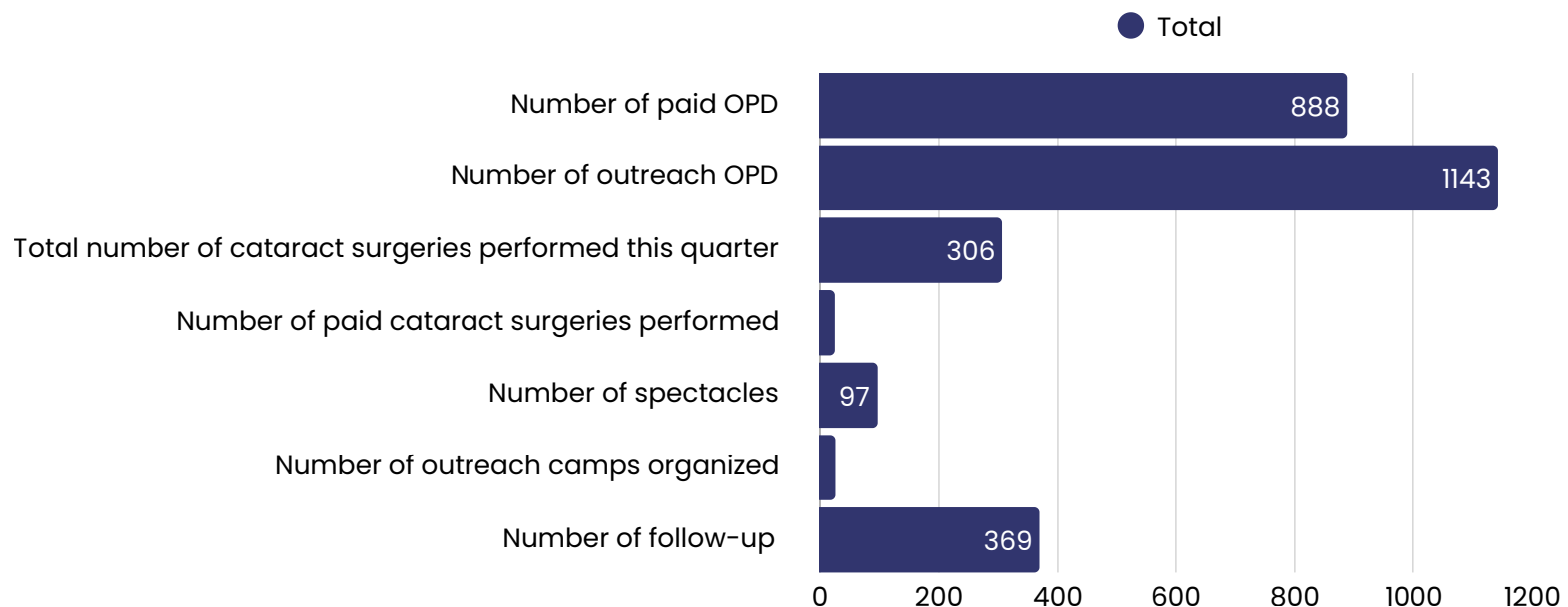
# Mahatma Gandhi Netralaya



From the 2007 vision of providing quality eye care to the underserved rural population Alwar, to construction of MGN in 2017, the hospital focuses on providing secondary-level eye care.

## Highlight

- 25 paid cataract surgeries were performed and 26 outreach camps were organized in 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter.
- Outreach OPD increased by 20% in 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter by 191 more OPDs performed.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter witnessed a dip in paid OPD by 137 points.



# Mahatma Gandhi Netralaya



Razza Khan, aged 53 years a resident of Nandhaneri village in Alwar, comes from a financially weak family and is the sole earning member of his household. Heading his family of four sons and three daughters through the poor economic condition, he had been ignoring his eye problem for a long time. Over time, his vision deteriorated to 6/60, which made it difficult for him to continue working.

As a free eye-checkup camp was organized in his area by Mahatma Gandhi Netralaya (NGO Sapna), Razza Khan got his eyes examined there.

The examination diagnosed cataract in his eyes, with prompt action required. After all consultation, on 26 September 2025, he underwent successful surgery. The very next day, his vision improved to 6/6, allowing him to see clearly again. He has now returned to work with renewed confidence.

Razza Khan expressed his gratitude emotionally:  
“I never imagined that my eyesight would return. The camp identified my problem, and Mahatma Gandhi Netralaya performed my operation completely free of cost. Now I can work again and support my family. May God bless everyone with such kindness.”

# Mahatma Gandhi Netralaya



Chote Lal ji, aged 75 years is a resident of Laxmangarh, Alwar. He lives with his eldest of the 3 sons. However, recently he began experiencing difficulty in identifying objects. It became very acute where his vision dropped to 6/60, making him handicapped to organize his own life independently.

After visiting the doctors at Mahatma Gandhi Netralaya on 12<sup>th</sup> October 2025 his vision was found to be very low making it impossible for him to identify items far away. Cataract that was found, negatively impacted his life. Cataract operation was suggested to Chote Lal ji, which was successfully carried out on 13<sup>th</sup> October

# Sapna IT College



IT College was started on May 1<sup>st</sup> 2023, to equip students with essential financial skills, especially to the rural youth with the help of Tally Education Pvt. Ltd

# Jai Prakash Narayan Trauma Center, AIIMS

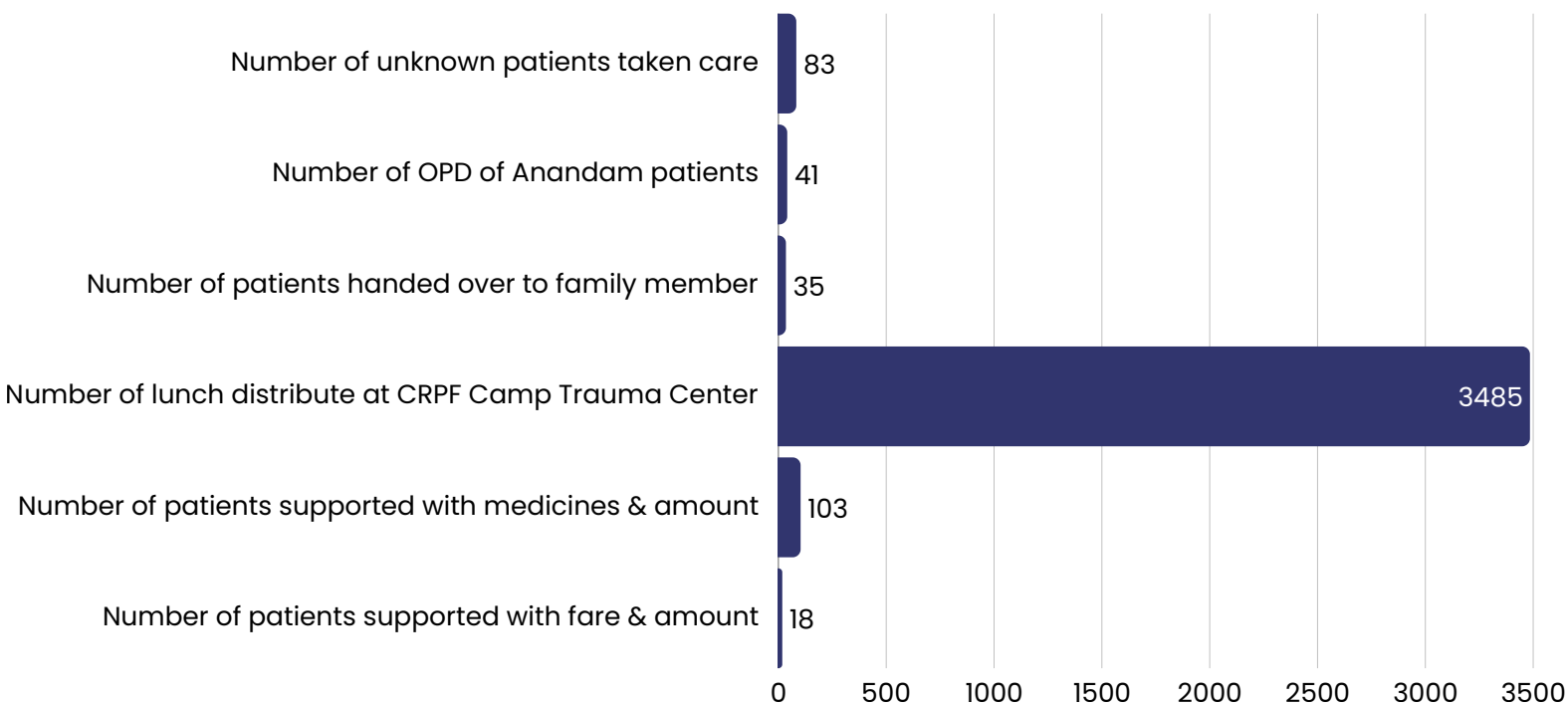


The JPNA social counter of the NGO began in 2007 supporting the nursing care, pre and post surgical needs, ambulance services, nutritional and rehabilitation needs of the patients.

## Highlight

- Social counter distributed 22 general kits and 68 coconut oil to the patients.
- 18 diagnostic tests were performed (X-ray, MRI and ultrasound) along with 20 ortho aids were distributed ( wheel chair, walker, suction machine, air mattress and DLSO brace) to the patients
- 19 patients were rehabilitated to Anandam program of the NGO

# Safdarjung Hospital



One of the first program of NGO Sapna to support the poor, began at the Dharamshala ward of Safdarjung hospital in 2004. To address the patient load of the hospital, the social counter of the NGO supports the food & nutritional needs, money for diagnostic tests & medicines, surgical & post – surgical of the patients and their families.

## Highlight

- 9516 kits of breakfast lunches, dinners distributed to the patients
- 33 Ortho aids were distributed including wheelchair, walker, air mattress, suction machine, oxygen concentrator, braces, crutches and DLSO brace
- 112 diagnostic tests were performed with the help of aid including MRI, blood test, X-ray, wound management, USG and pet CT.
- 76 patients were supported through medicines which ranged between Rs. 18,000 – Rs. 44,000.
- 2 patients were handed over to their family in the quarter

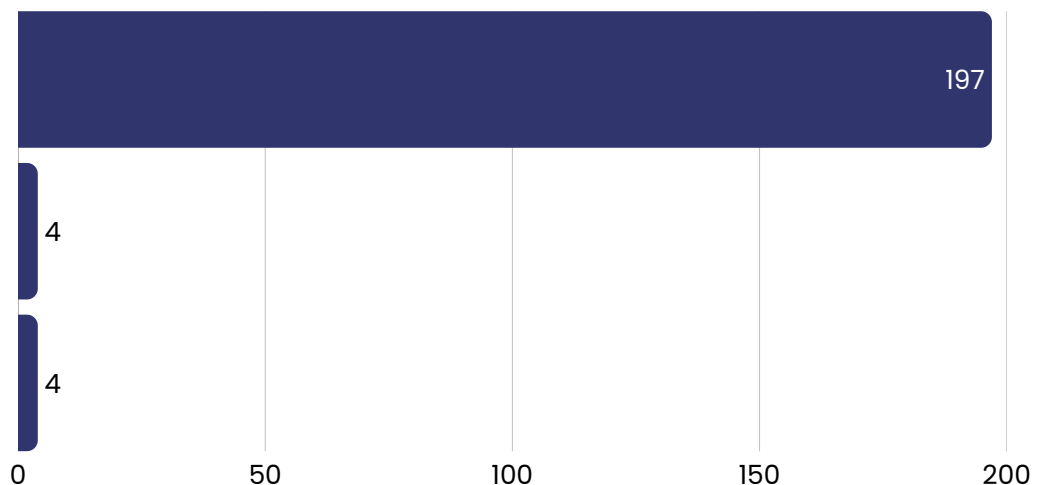

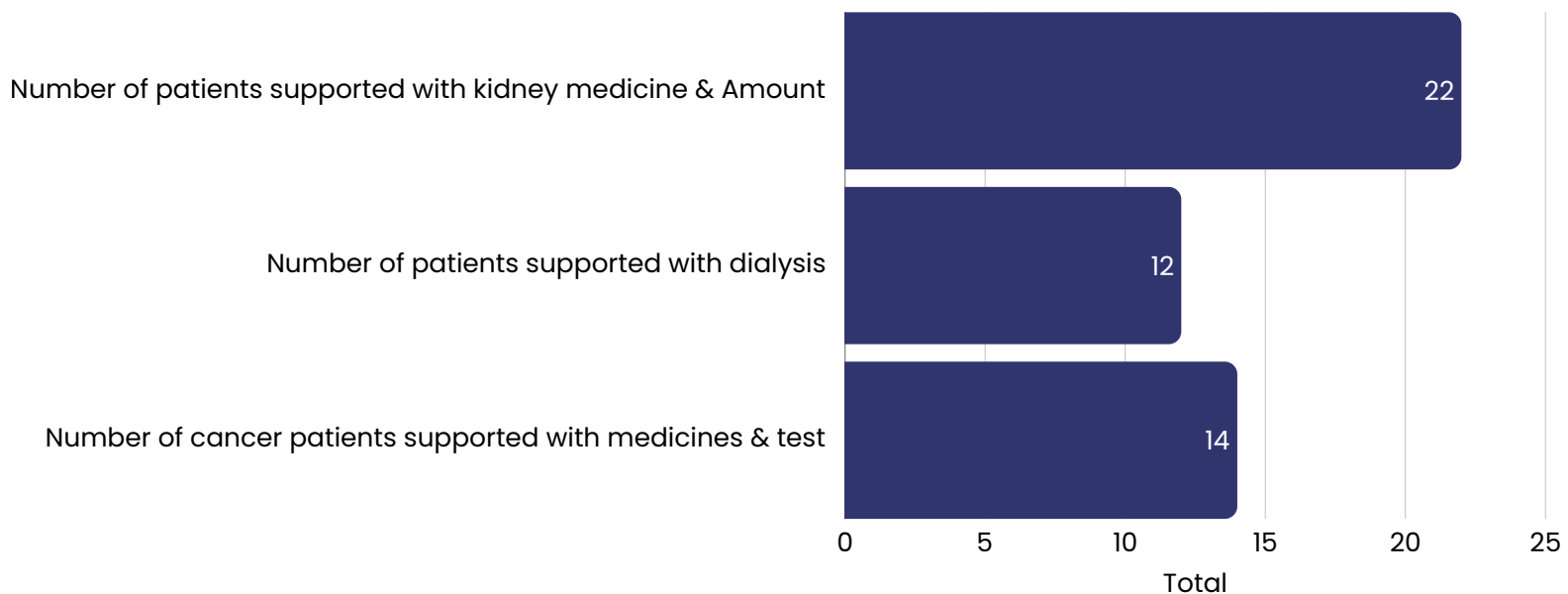
# Kidney and Cancer Patients

- Rs. 20,700 has been spent on cancer patients in need of medicines and tests.



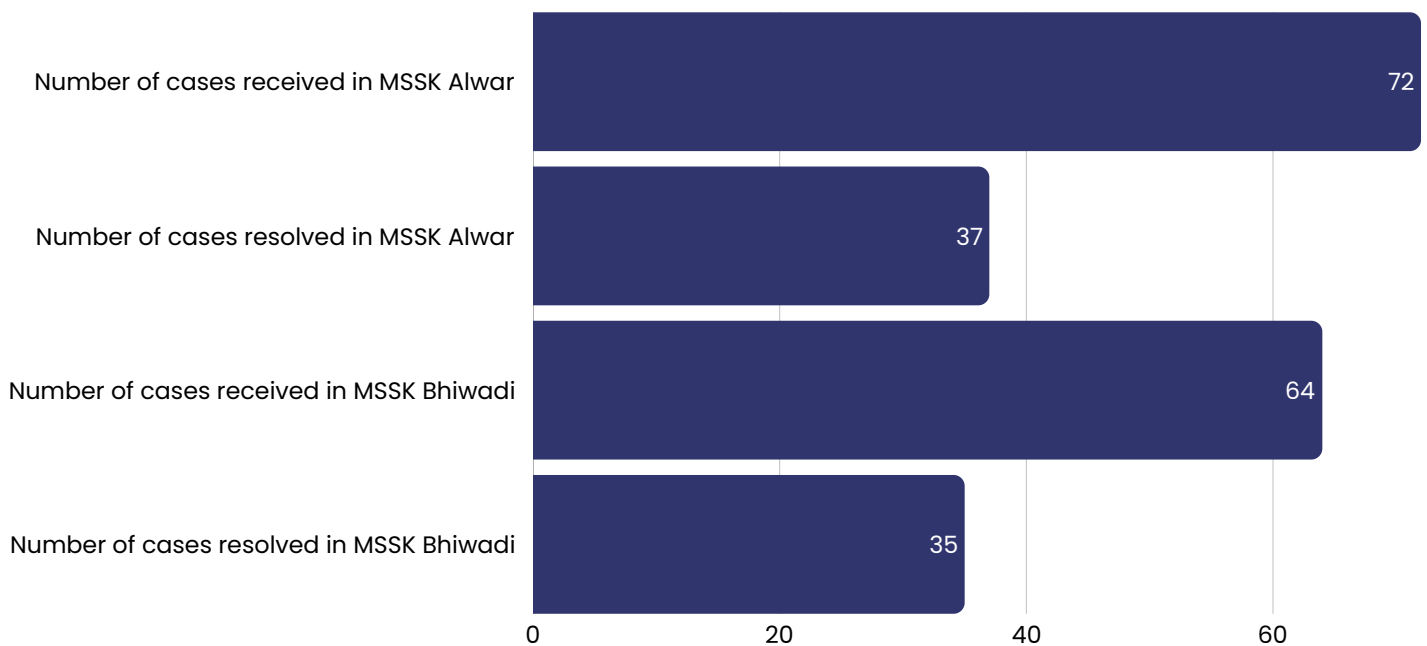
# Mahila Suraksha & Seva Kendra

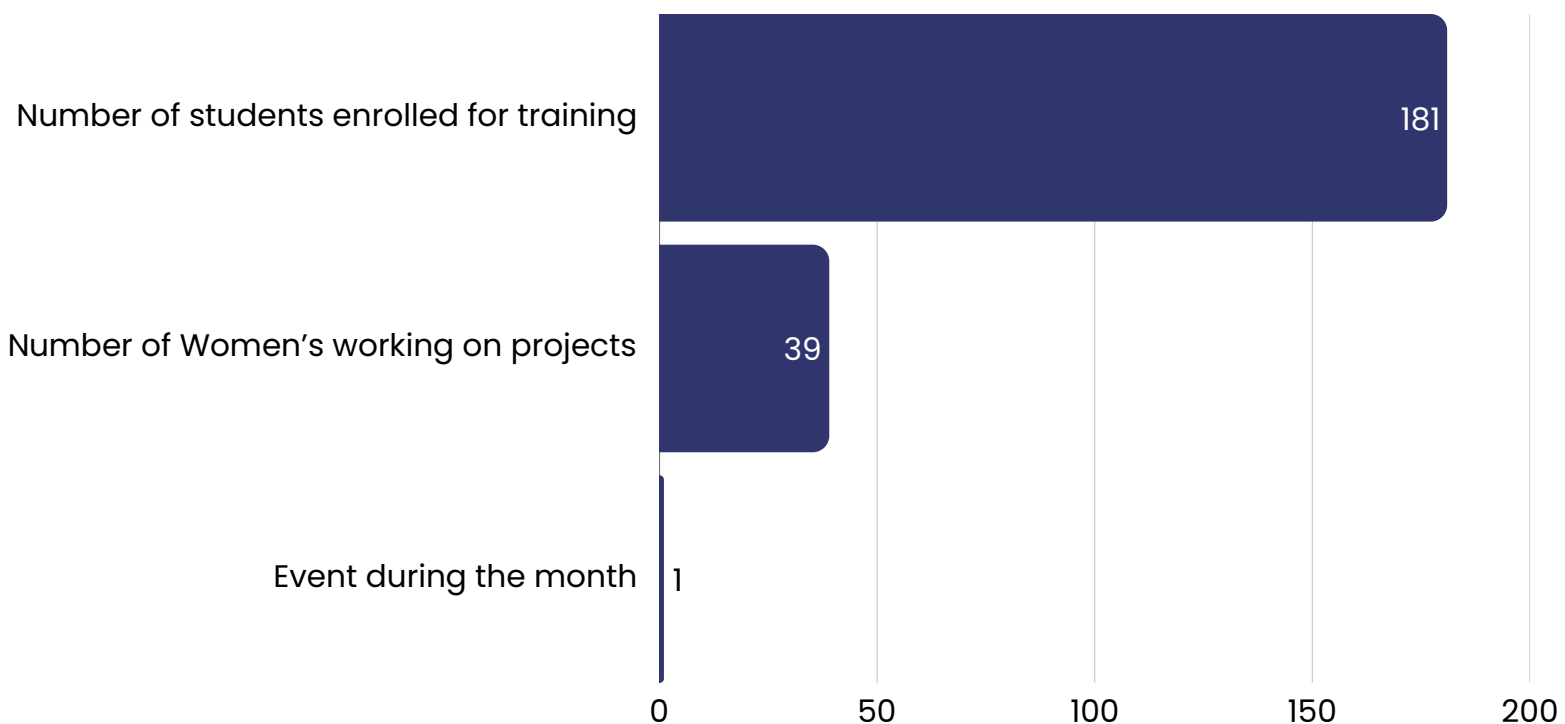
# Skill Development Center
