



# D.C JAIN, IPS(R).



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- **D. C. Jain joined the Indian Police Service (IPS) in the year 1991 and belongs to Rajasthan cadre. In the state, he has worked in many capacities as Superintendents of Police (SP), Inspector General of Police (IGP) and Additional Director General of Police (ADGP).**
- **As Superintendent of Police, he worked in the Security and Crime branches of the Police Headquarters and headed the police forces of Bundi, Jhalawar and Kota Districts of Rajasthan.**
- **As Inspector General of Police, he worked in the Anti-Corruption Bureau of the State and headed the Jodhpur and Jaipur Ranges of Rajasthan Police.**
- **As Additional Director General of Police, he headed the Vigilance, Personnel and Headquarters branches of the Rajasthan Police as well as the State Crime Record Bureau and Rajasthan Forensic Science Laboratory.**

- Mr. Jain worked in the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) during 2002-2010 as SP and DIG and 2019-2023 as Joint Director, Additional Director and Special Director CBI. He superannuated from the post of Special Director, CBI on 31st Oct 2023.
- Before joining IPS, Mr. Jain worked in the private sector as an IT professional at Delhi and Jaipur from 1987 to 1989. From 1989 to 1991 he worked as a teaching professional in a Govt. Polytechnic College in Rajasthan.
- Mr. Jain has done Bachelor of Engineering in Electronics from the Malaviya National Institute of Technology at Jaipur. He has done Master's in 'Applied Criminology and Police Management' from the Cambridge University, UK on full scholarship.
- He has been awarded the Master's degree with distinction and his Master's thesis was chosen for display in the library of the Institute of Criminology, University of Cambridge.



- While working in CBI, Mr. Jain was part of the Indian delegation which negotiated and finalized Extradition Treaty and Mutual Legal Assistance Treaty (MLAT) in Criminal Matters with Mexico in 2006. He represented India in the International Senior Seminar held on "Effective Legal & Practical Measures to Combat Corruption" in Japan in 2008. The paper presented by him in this Senior Seminar was published in the journal of the Ministry of Justice, Government of Japan.
- While working in Rajasthan Police, he joined the United Nations Mission in Kosovo for a year during 2000-2001 and contributed in raising the new police force for Kosovo.
- Mr. Jain did the prestigious 49th National Security and Strategic Studies course at the National Defence College, New Delhi in 2009.





- From 2019 to 2023, he represented India in the working group of INTERPOL constituted to review legal provisions relating to working of governance bodies of the Interpol. He attended physical meetings of the working group at Paris, Lyon and Singapore in this regard.
- While working in CBI, Mr. Jain handled many important and high-profile cases which includes Chandigarh High Court Judge case, Ghaziabad Court Provident Fund Scam case, Tehelka Tape Cases, Delhi Cooperative Group Housing Societies Scam Cases, National Stock Exchange Co-location Scam case, Land for Job Scam cases, Chinese Visa Scam case and Balasore Railway Mishap case, to name a few.
- Keeping in view his interest and abilities in dealing with matters relating to legal issues, Director CBI had appointed him as Chairperson of the newly created Empowered Committee of CBI in 2020. During his tenure as Chairperson till his superannuation, this committee has been instrumental in resolving many legally complex issues faced by the agency and issuing appropriate guidelines to its field formations.

- Post superannuation, keeping in view his vast experience in dealing with issues relating to Bank Frauds while working in CBI, the Indian Banks Association (IBA) in consultation with the Department of Financial Services,
- Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India constituted a 7 member committee of serving and retired distinguished Banking senior professionals under his chairmanship to examine various gamut of Bank Frauds and submit a report to effectively handle the same. This Committee has since submitted its report to IBA.





- Presently Mr. Jain is working as Advisor (Regulatory and Risk Management) in Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) since August 2024, as Advisor (Information Technology) in Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC) since September 2024 and as Consultant to Bureau of Police Research & Development (BPR&D), Govt. of India since August 2024 on implementation of new criminal laws in India.
- Mr Jain is a member of the National Advisory Committee on E-Gaming Regulations, constituted under a Memorandum of Understanding between National Law University Delhi and the E-Gaming Federation to provide strategic guidance and oversight to research initiatives focused on shaping the regulatory framework for the e-gaming industry in India.

- **Mr Jain is also the Chief Operating Officer of the Indian Police Foundation (IPF), the national think tank on issues relating to the Indian Police.**
- **Mr. Jain is a resource person for capacity building in various National and State level administrative and police training institutions such as Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration (LBSNAA), Sardar Vallabh Patel National Police Academy (SVPNPA), BPR&D training institutions, CBI Training Academy, Delhi Police Training Academy, Telangana State Police Academy, Rajasthan Police Academy, Gujarat Police Academy, Delhi Metro Rail Academy, Goa Institute of Public Administration & Rural Development (GIPARD), Assam Administrative Staff College and Dr. MCR HRD Institute of Telangana.**
- **Mr. Jain is recipient of the United Nations Peace Medal in the year 2001, Police Medal for Meritorious Services in the year 2007, the President's Police Medal for Distinguished Services in the year 2017 and DGP Disk of Rajasthan Police for exemplary work in the year 2018.**
